

Content Modifications

Content Modifications represent WHAT needs to be modified; the curriculum/curriculum standards.

The following, *in italics*, are offered as possible content modification language options.

1. When the student can participate in and demonstrate knowledge of grade-level standards yet requires limiting the focus of the curriculum.

Curriculum modified to allow student to address key facts/concepts for the following curriculum areas:

- ELA
- Mathematics
- Science
- History
- Digital Literacy
- Arts
- Health
- Foreign Language
- Vocational
- Social/Emotional Standards (for Pre-school and K only)

2. When the student requires curriculum modified at or near grade-level standards for level of complexity.

Curriculum modified to the

- more complex
- mid complex
- less complex

level of entry-points of grade-level standards (or below grade level standards – identify the level) for the following curriculum areas

- ELA
- Math
- Science
- History

3. When the student requires curriculum modified below grade-level: (Note: This level of curriculum modification should be used sparingly).
